Read Me: Default Certificate Expiration Issue

CAUTION: A device using the default Dell signed certificate and participating in a Virtual Link Trunking (VLT) or SmartFabric Services (SFS) cluster will experience network connectivity loss on or after July 27, 2021.

Issue: OS10 images from version 10.4.1.4 through version 10.5.0.7P3 contain a default x.509 certificate to establish secure connections with peer devices for VLT and SFS. The x.509 certificate expires July 27, 2021.

If this default certificate is not updated in production networks, after the certificate expires, any subsequent switch reboot, link flap, operator-triggered configuration change, vMotion, or other network event causes network connectivity loss for a VLT or SFS cluster.

When all switches in a cluster are running version 10.5.1.0 or later, certificates are not used and therefore not susceptible to the certificate expiry issue.
